Football celebrations at Glasgow Cross Standing Item – progress update

- Update on football celebrations
- 1 TF was invited as were reps of MCCC to a meeting with Kaukab Stewart

- Attended by reps x 2 from SPL, 2 x CFC, 2 RFC, 2x PS, 1x GCC, 1 from Scottish Government at Hampden
- No successful outcome to the meeting
- PS they can't intervene until there is illegality
- TF pointed out that drinking in the street is illegal
- There was discussion about having a celebration event in the grounds
- KS was confused as John Paul Taylor pointed out there was an event when the cup was awarded at the end of the season
- Discussion about having a celebratory event at the stadium they won't do that in the stadium because alcohol is banned in stadia
- The clubs are going to go back and advise their fan we know that fans are already communicating with each other about the end of season celebrations
- They are tweeting about it telling each other to get prepared they want toilets and bins and perhaps even on Glasgow Green
- Likely to happen on 17 / 18 May Supt John Menzies and Johnny Waters were there from PS
- Afraid this is it if anyone does have any information please pass it to us
- TF the man from GCC said it would cost 100k to set up a fan zone it costs that much to clear up after the event last year
- If there are any updates, we will let you know
- Q is there anything we can do to prevent this from happening every year? I've seen my neighbour be assaulted in our courtyard and it happens every year
- PS there is nothing in their planning currently they need at least 2 wins to clinch the title at least this year the dates are looking like it will happen sooner.
 CB = give me information and I will pass the details on to the correct parties
- Cllr O'Lone as a local councillor we have not been involved. They have been calling for an event to be organised on Glasgow Green. If there is an organised event with a proper fan zone it makes it much easier to manage. We know every year it is going to happen, and I have supported that something should happen in Glasgow Green for this end of town or Bellahouston on the other side of town
- ACTION Cllr O' Lone to take it back to the GCC and to John Grady
- LS for Craig act on the feedback that we gave last year. Get there earlier last year it was midday that they started to congregate and began kicking balls into the traffic. LS phoned 101 with hours wait. 999 told it wasn't an emergency. When Extinction Rebellion set up a boat there were 24 riot vans, and they were moved on in a couple of hours. If they dealt with it sooner, it might not come to this. CB difficult to police if we are not sure it is going to happen. Need to take the ground early. Set the tone early. LS left it late last year

Police Scotland Report

- Good work targeting drug dealing and anti-social behaviour. Male arrested with £1500 worth of cannabis charged with dealing had his car seized
- Enforcement around the red-light area one charged for kerb crawling
- High level deal caught mid deal
- Group of youths banned from the city centre are now congregating in this area breaking into closes, stealing from Morrison, filming for likes on social media they were arrested last night ongoing work to get them in from of the fiscal asap
- Personnel wise 3 x new probationers for May and then they will be going to the response teams
- Planning for the big summer events Sgt & Insp are trying to minimise people being sent to events
- Working with GCC on security and safety improvements to the general area
- Planning to target local dealers
- Need residents to be heard regarding the anti-social behaviour and encourage
 people to give statements we have three months to gather information for
 prosecution we can take statement anonymously TF when we had the
 meeting about the Thistle the residents were out in force will leave a card with
 details to be publicised for residents to contact PS anonymously
- Cllr O'Lone I have been dealing with the state of Calton and several streets because it is bad it needs to be cleaned up
- Cllr O'Lone to take the details and pass it on to the appropriate people
- There are needles lying about the place on the pavement
- PS can offer support and there is no reason not to talk to us about what is happening
- Cllr O'Lone one of the things I have noticed a lot of young male teens riding e-scooters doing it at night without lights, going through red lights PS there is a National Day of Action coming up soon
- The law on e-scooters and bikes essentially if it's a child's toy not a problem once it gets above a certain speed it will be counted as a motor vehicle and all laws apply speeds are increasing, and the potential damage is getting worse
- This is the same with the e-bikes above a certain power rating it is classed as a motorbike and it must be taxed, insured and correct license must be held road traffic law applies
- MT it is illegal to ride on a footpath it is illegal to ride them on the pavements one of the compel at Stuart St is the lead on this and is taking them off people on a daily basis if they fail to stop we are limited to deal with these so we have to be careful how we deal with this CB to let us know what happens at the day of action
- MoP Q on the topic of cycling there is a shed being put up on Gallowgate want to know more TF ask MB when it gets to her

Local issues with NRS

- Follow on from Elko St there will be a deep clean in the area
- At the last meeting we mentioned the recruitment drive we are now trying to understand how best to use the additional resources
- Who can we be specifically more proactive with things like drug paraphernalia –
 we respond but we haven't had enough people hope to get out daily to deal
 with this before it gets reported
- We are getting more reports via the website and via the app and I hope that this is being seen because we can target areas that are not on our radar – while I am here, I am happy to be told of any other areas that need deep cleans or for more regular checking = places that aren't so obvious
- Response- Claythorn St and Ave and London Road and Gallowgate- between
 Morrisons and Glasgow Green drug paraphernalia there. It is used a lot by
 commuters that park there loads of rubbish there is a lot of room to make this
 more pedestrian friendly perhaps for people with mobility issues people
 struggle to cross and speed regulating improvements and improved lighting
 which is already on the list will put stuff on the website
- Q about the bike thing some of the bike shelters are put in place by housing Might be Wheatley or Lowther opposite Thompson on the Gallowgate are there plans for any more and where might they go there used to be a place on the website to put suggestions for where they might be needed ACTION MB to look into this and see if this is still the case and will let us know
- Q there will be a deep clean in which area? MB each neighbourhood had on a yearly agenda when the deep clean team would be in the area MB would point out which streets needed attention this would happen twice a year but other things happened to prevent this we are now hoping there will be a deep clean team in each neighbourhood so we don't have to wait our turn and we will be able to look more proactive and then base additional cleans on the data being received rom the app
- The deep clean is weeding, removing litter, removing rubbish / fly tipping Tobago St, Stevenson St stuff lying around for over 2 years the problem is that this is on private land and opposite the garage and it is owned by a land lord and he has had notice served and still hasn't taken it away they can't take the stuff away in case the landlord is upset by that it needs to be an extremes case before ht council will go onto private land to deal with it MB has been dealing with it but the landlord has taken away the rubbish but you can't see because of the height of the weeds
- At best the council can clean the periphery
- Public realm they can do something about

- Litter pick last year will there be another organised on they tend to be community led and we will support it = let MB know and she will help with that
- On the website put in NIES in the search function and you will be directed to the appropriate person
- MoP if there is a litter pick done by the community are we restricted to the public realm – MB they support the pick with their insurance and making sure you are safe – they encourage you not to stray from the public realm for safety reasons
- MT I wrote to all 4 MPs and the councillors about St Andrews Street because it was a mess it was cleaned and by the next week it was covered in sick, rubbish and needles again there is a lot of traffic through there and a regular clean would be useful there is a business on there and their rubbish gets scattered
- TF just be reminded that some flower beds on Duke St which were installed were taken away again MB they appeared before they were ready to go in-ACTION MB will be finding out what date they are going to be installed finally and why they arrived and then were removed again dates and planning possible not aligning

The Thistle Centre Progress Update

- We were unable to be represented at the last meeting and TF has no minutes yet, but she is intending to go to the next meeting
- Two things TF has seen in the press retired cop says drugs should be legalised as an enormous amount of time is spent on drugs
- Leader of hate Lib Dem's in Scotland has said that we need more safer drugs consumption facilities in Scotland

The People's Palace and Winter Gardens

 - Want to create an innovative social history museum
 - Dynamic community oiled museum and space including programming to include local people and how we will manage the museum

 - o Connected museum connect to the green and the environment
 - Attractive in the east end and bring a positive economic impact to the east end
- Project status report

- o Architecture conservation and restoration in the building
- Better services infrastructure and plant
- More energy efficiency
- Access improvements
- o Still at the early stage of the project still building the team
- o Have an architectural team involved with the project
- This will start to develop
- Development phase
- Large chunk of funding from the lottery
- o Trying to recruit people to the project
- Trying to find less traditional ways through the employment process into the project
- In the last 2 years we have worked with community groups -= there is a proposal form - there have been over 120 suggestion which are being internally reviewed, and we are developing stories
- In community engagement we have an external facilitator who will help us develop session
- We are setting up a youth panel to make sure we capture your views
- We are setting up a community partners panel
- We are doing a Glasgow Green use survey
- In terms of the architects we are meeting with an access panel to see how people can access the space
- There will be a changing places toilet
- There will be an educational and learning space for use for learning and for the community
- Q from Mark all this sounds it will take some time which not get some plants
 in, get the glass fixed and get it open at this stage our focus is on going forward
 and getting the planning done
- Is this just a feasibility study or is there real funding yes, we need to get this together and we need to understand how much it will cost to get this sorted and reopened
- The glass bit at the back will this be as it was as part of the consultation we will have consultation about the winter gardens they will be reunited and will be one whole venue run by Glasgow life museums
- Is there a time frame the lottery application is due by November this year 0- we need a concept and the application for November this year and funding possibly by March 2026 with a view to reopening by the end of 2027
- We need to understand the scope of the works and what people want to see
- Once we understand that, we will have a better view of what is required

- Funding when you say lottery funding applications in November there is no confirmed funding – we have lottery consultants, and we are trying to get funding from the lottery
- Will the lottery cover all the costs no the council will be covering part of the cost, and we are seeking other external funding because the council can't cover it
- I hope it is not going to be a rip out and a modernisation inside this would be terrible sympathetic restoration and improved access rather than throwing out the baby with the bath water
- It is a listed building, so we need to conserve the building and the architecture, and we have gone back to the original building
- With taking the old museum out we are discovering the original building underneath
- As Friends of PPGG = we have put in to be part of the community partners planning. We are trying to watch everything and thanks for referring it to the winter gardens not the glasshouse we have done an extensive survey, and we have given you the report, so you know what the people want
- We have had several meetings this week and we are engaging more widely with the community – now we have the team there the engagement will increase – Q are we on the community partners panel? No, we were unaware of it
- Glasgow 850 is doing a pop up of the Peoples Palace exhibits between June and November – this is something to look out for
- We didn't know about the timetable for the next part of proceedings
- As part of this it will come to the planning process we are getting things planned
- Q who is your external facilitator yes- I can provide the name I don't have it on me
- We genuinely welcome the interest and want community input into the project

Planning Issues Including Weekly Planning List

- There are 2 applications and one proposal
- One for a short term let and one for a building of 42 dwellings for THENUE round near the old school
- Planning proposal for 55 flats at London Rd, Stevenson St and Bain St
- Attended a planning education session run by the council
- There is a spreadsheet of all applications which we will reply to in due course
- Short term let there are a lot of problems where there are shared facilities this one has its own door all neighbours have been consulted and there are no comments are present as a community council we oppose those with shared facilities. If anyone does object, please contact me no comments from the crowd

- Calton Centre – old Tureen St School – façade will be kept, and they will build flats – one comment has been raised that the façade will crumble when the development happens. The plans show a modern build with the façade. The site is a mess at the moment, and it is affordable housing by TheNue. If you want to add anything. As a CC we support this. If anyone has concerns let the CC know and we will be submitting responses
