#### **SPT**

John took part in the Strathclyde Partnership for Transport (SPT) Bus Summit this month, where discussions focused on the future of bus services across the region. He met with industry professionals to consider SPT's work on improving services, including exploring a franchised bus system like those in London and Manchester, though such a model would require greater public subsidy. Key challenges were highlighted, including slow bus speeds, unreliable services, and poor road conditions. John supports SPT's efforts to address these issues and is committed to helping deliver a faster, fairer and more accessible bus network.

### December 2025

#### **Cats Protection**

John thoroughly enjoyed meeting with Cats Protection in Parliament, where their manifesto took centre stage. Key highlights included the call for compulsory microchipping, an end to breeding cats with extreme physical traits, greater regulation of cat cafés, and raising awareness that lilies are highly toxic to cats. Of course, one important question still lingers, should John get a cat or a dog before he retires?

### **GirlGuiding Scotland**

John met with Girlguiding Scotland in Parliament to discuss a range of important issues, including girls' safety when socialising, travelling, at school, and online, as well as equal access to healthcare, and expanding opportunities in sport/youth work. They also highlighted the growing interest from girls wanting to join, while acknowledging that a shortage of volunteer leaders is making it difficult to meet demand.

The need for affordable, accessible housing remains pressing, particularly for care-experienced young people who require greater support in securing a safe place to live. Concerns were also raised about families currently residing in unsuitable accommodation and what can be done to improve the situation.
